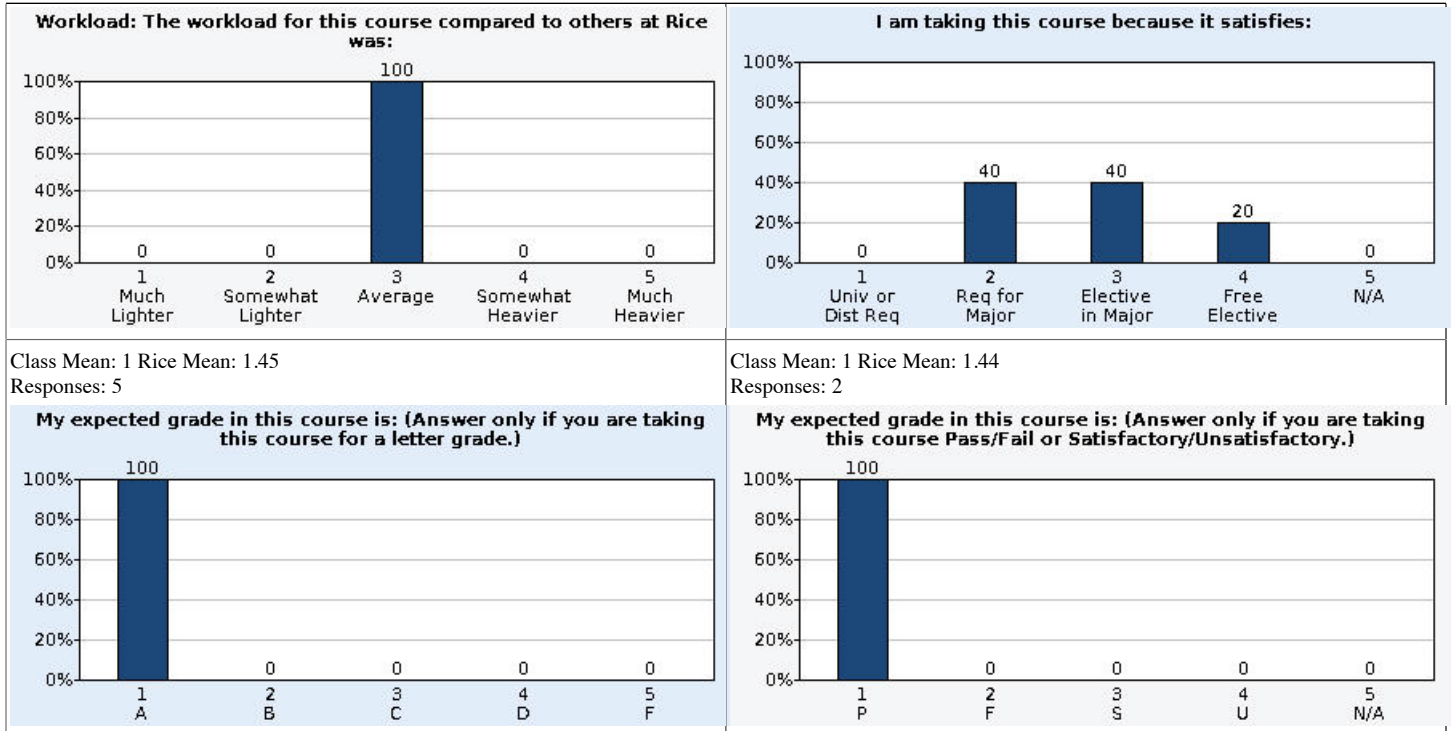

This is a seminar on Timothy Williamson's book Knowledge and Its Limits. I think it is an important book for 21st century epistemology. I highly recommend it.





